

Terms & Conditions for the kids art classes:

Each class can have up to 50 children and adults taking part (annual birthday parties are an exception to this).

All our Artists are DBS checked

All parents/carers/guardians will have to sign a consent form, photo permission and a waiver agreeing to these terms & conditions for their children to attend.

All classes are free and we will provide materials however we may mention additional things to bring such as aprons/old clothes or recyclable household materials for different projects.

Please inform us if your child is allowed to leave the premises on their own or if they have to wait to be picked up by a parent or guardian.

Please let us know about any relevant medical conditions or allergies that you feel we should be aware of. If children have a medical condition that requires medication it is imperative they bring it to the session.

Class starts at 4pm - children are expected to turn up before 4pm to take part in the class and stay till 5pm. Holiday classes are 2-4pm and for those sessions we operate more on a drop in session basis where people are welcome to come in at any time.

Electronic devices are not permitted to be used during the sessions (unless in case of emergency re: mobile phones when agreed with session leader)

Unaccompanied children who are deemed to be causing disruption to others will be removed from the group and their parent/carer will be requested to collect them.

All personal property is the participants' responsibility, unless loss or damage is proven to be due to Cool it Art's negligence. Expensive and/or treasured items should not be brought to class. Suitable clothing should always be worn as acrylic paints can be difficult to remove from clothing.

We consider language, behaviour or action that is designed to be offensive or creates discrimination to any user of the Service or member of staff, unacceptable and will not be tolerated. If any behaviour at the class is considered inappropriate, the offending pupil or pupils will be given a clear warning. If the behaviour persists, the child or children will be given a second warning. If a pupil continues to ignore the teacher and is considered to be affecting the equilibrium of the whole class then a parent will be called and the pupil asked to leave.

Although all the materials we use are child friendly versions of paints/glue etc we will be using scissors too, all materials can carry a small risk when not used properly, but all children are supervised. Cool it Art is not responsible for your children's clothing remaining paint free.
