

Tangram Inspired Drawings



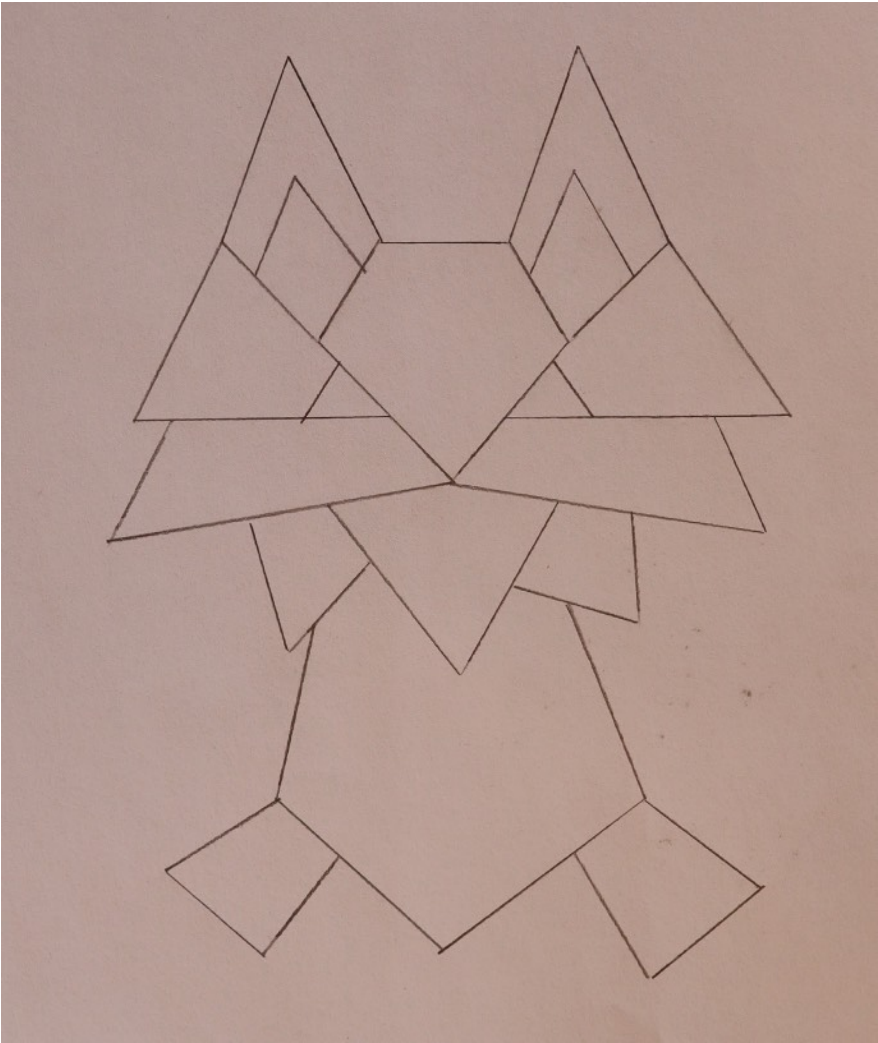

Tools and Materials:

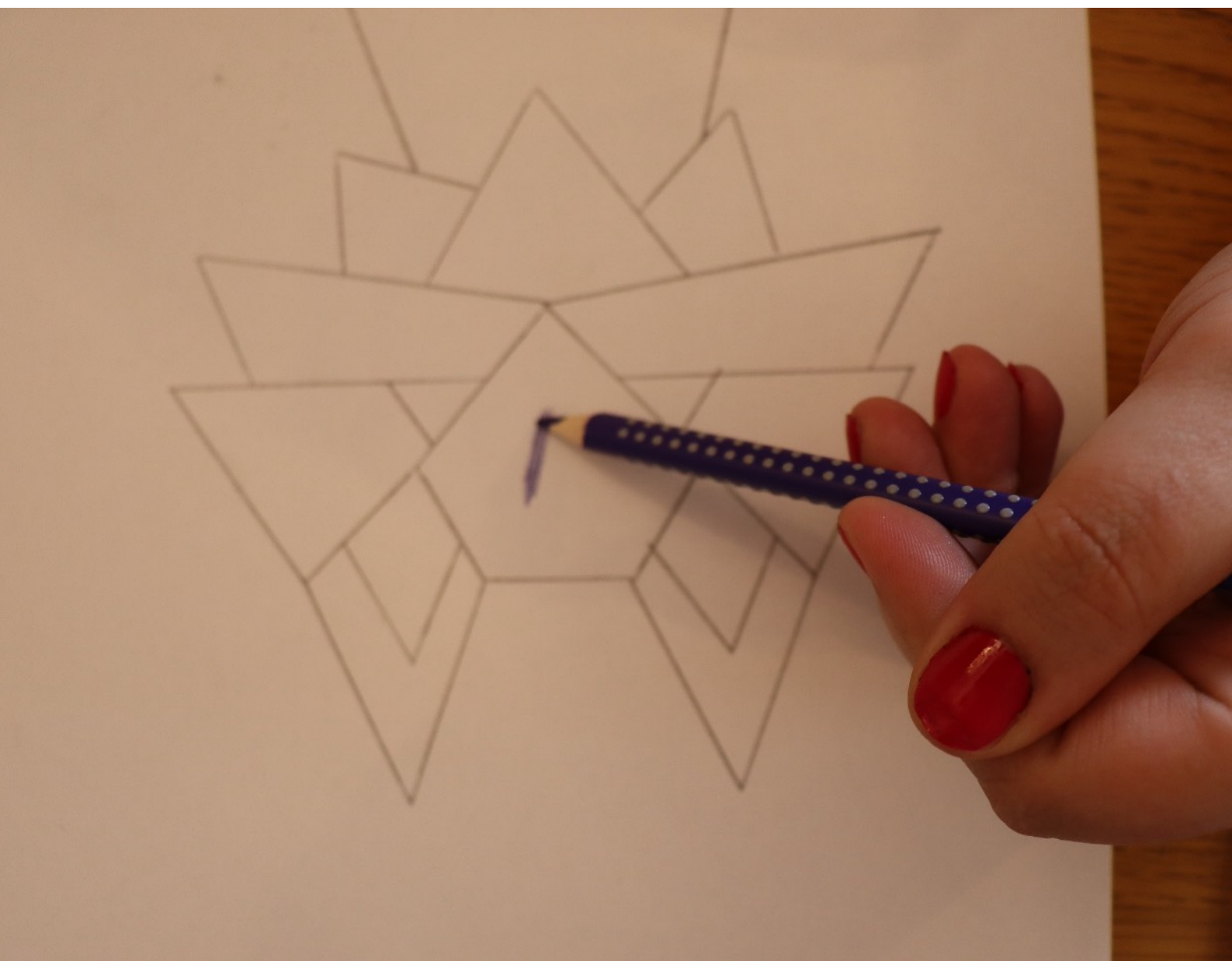
- A4 White Paper
- Pencil
- Colouring Pencils
- Ruler



First think about what it is you want to draw and then how that could be broken down into geometric shapes - we thought a simple fox could be fun!



Your drawing doesn't have to be perfectly measured more an overall look that it looks the same both side - once you are happy with it then you can start colouring it in, thinking about what colours look good where like so



Try not to have similar colours touching just so your image pops out more
