

Constructed Collage



Create your own “constructed collage” combining watercolour, paper-folding and a bit of concentration for this colourful collage

Tools and Materials:

- Black Paper
- White Paper
- Gluestick
- Scissors
- Watercolours
- Paintbrush
- Water



We used watercolours to create a vibrant image to then create the fan/wave collage - you can use pencils or felt tips if you prefer but we like the aesthetics and its a lot quicker to cover the whole page!



Once your paper is dry then you can start folding it to guide you where the folds need to go for the fan, you could measure it if you prefer, start by folding it in half



Then open it up and fold the outer edges in to the middle like so to create 4 sections



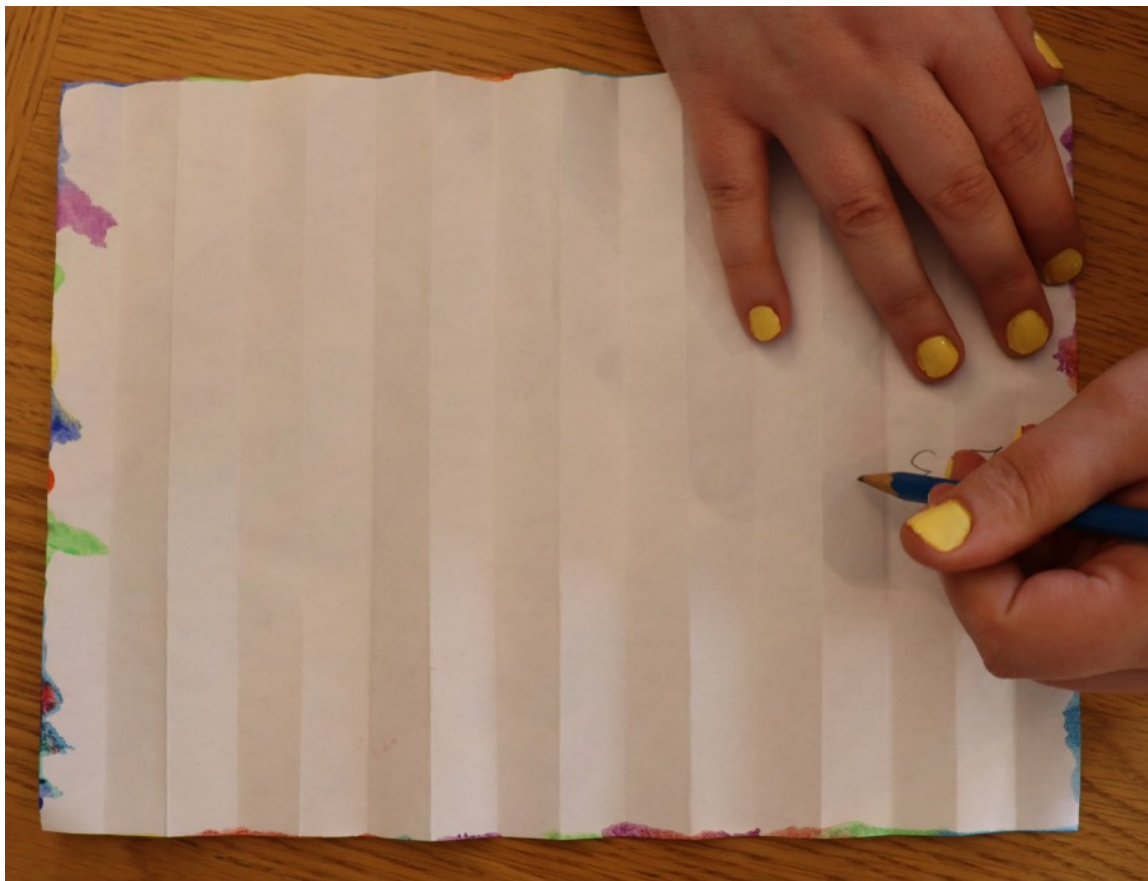
Once you have those lines start folding the paper to create lines in the middles of the folds like so, then star folding in half again



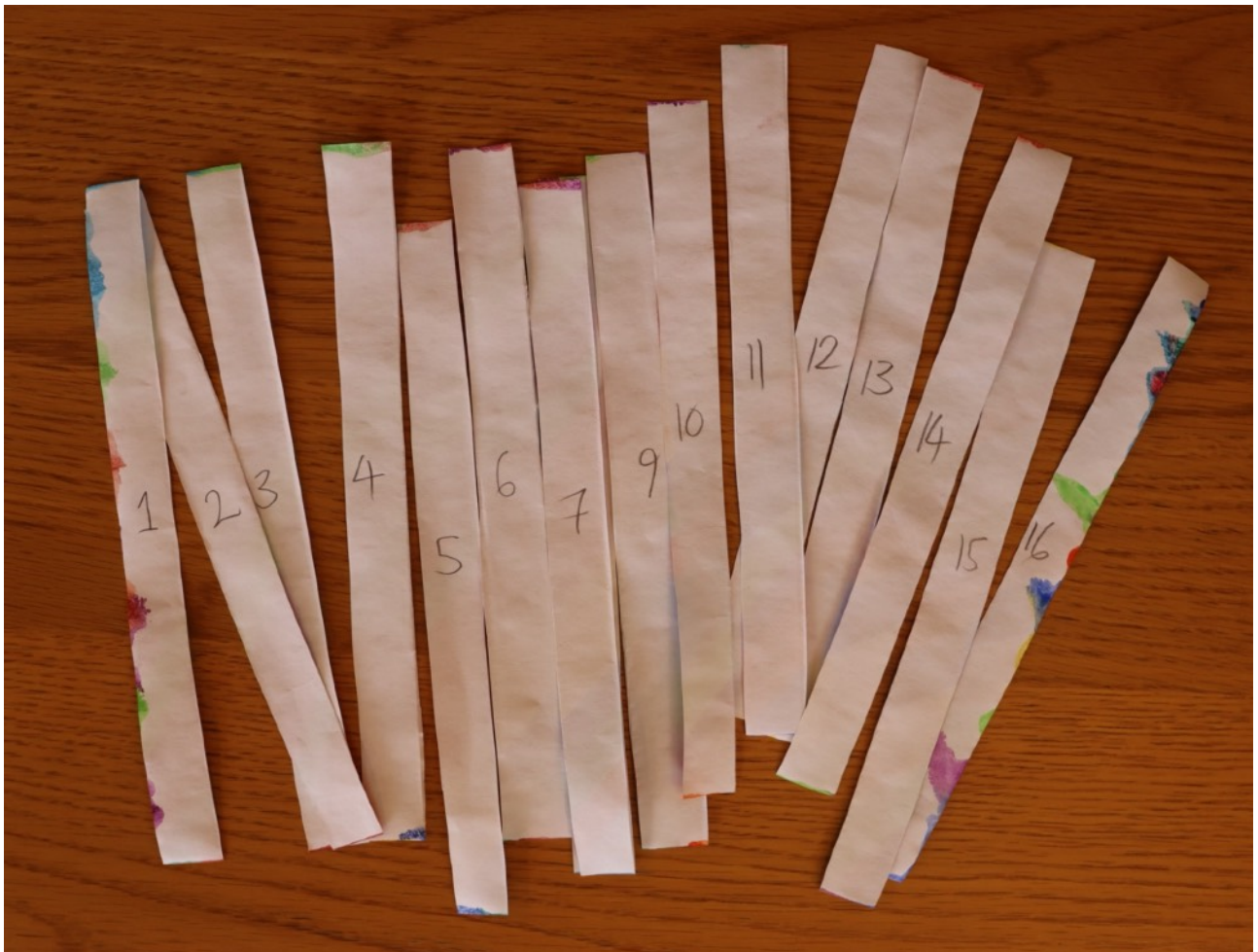
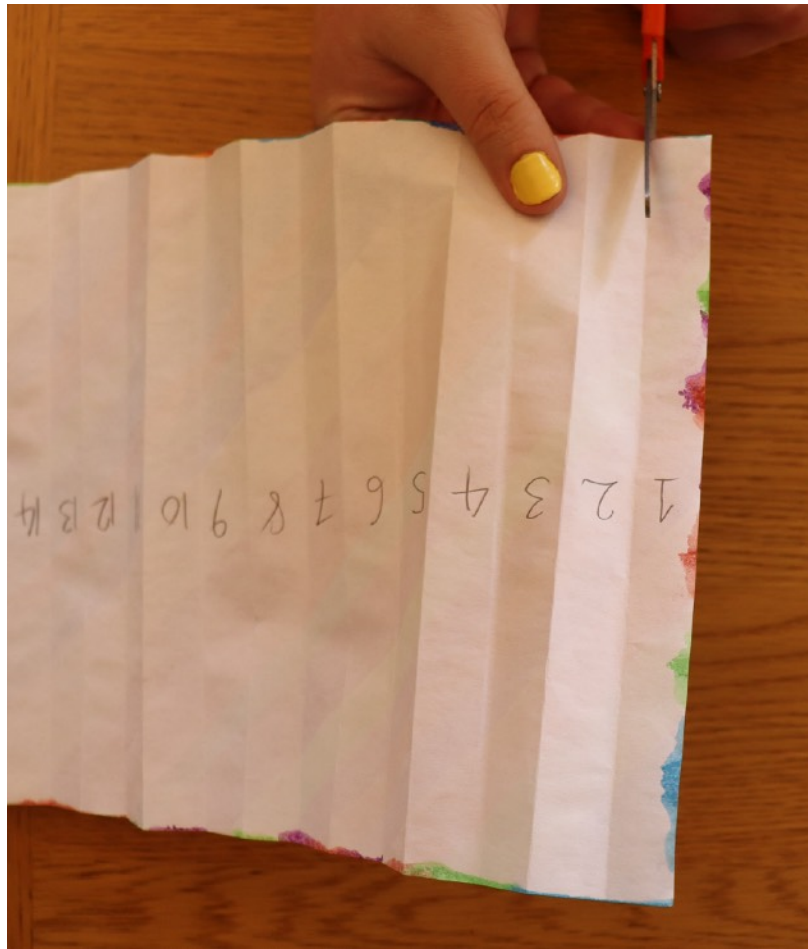
You should end up with your paper looking like this



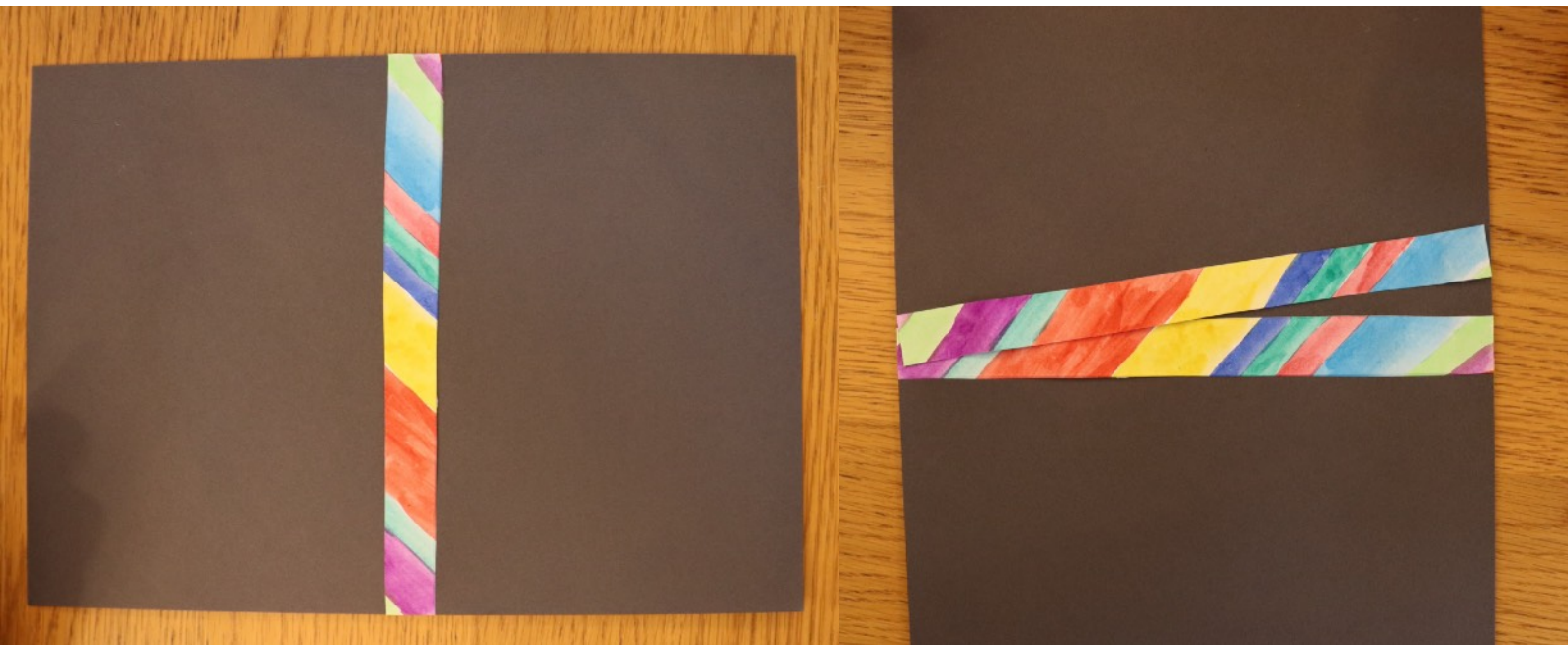
Flip it over and then number the sections - this is important for later so you can get the right order easily



Once all the numbers are done then cut the strips like so



Because you want a focal point if you have an even number of strips like we do get rid of one to have 15, taking the middle number 8 in this case stick it on the middle of your paper and then start with either the set of numbers before or after on one side to figure out the fanned shape like so. Glue them down when you are sure about the position



There you have it your very own “Constructed Collage”!
