

Hedgehog Collage



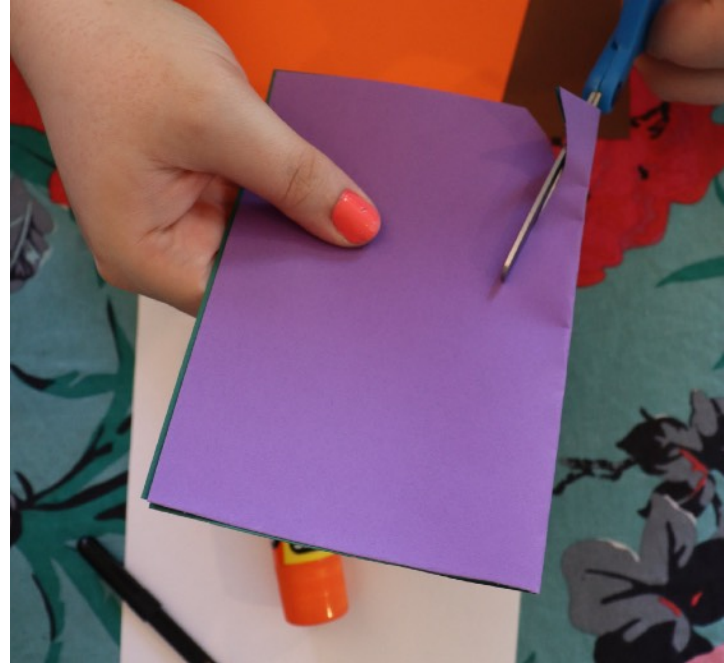
Inspired by Hedgehog Awareness Week which is the 5th-11th May we thought it would be fun to create Hedgehog Collages from simple leaf shapes

Tools and Materials:

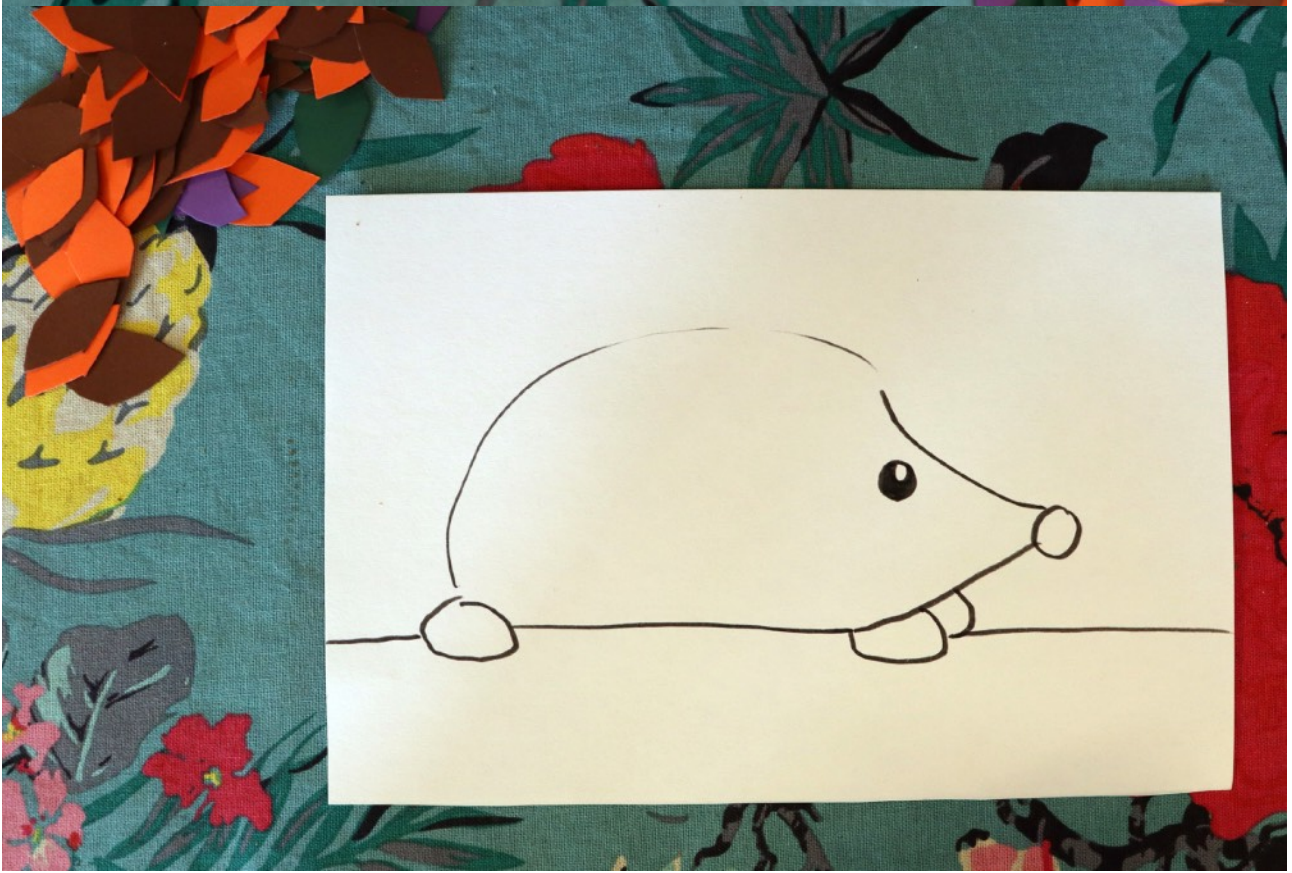
- Coloured Paper
- White A4 Paper
- Black Felt Tip
- Gluestick
- Scissors



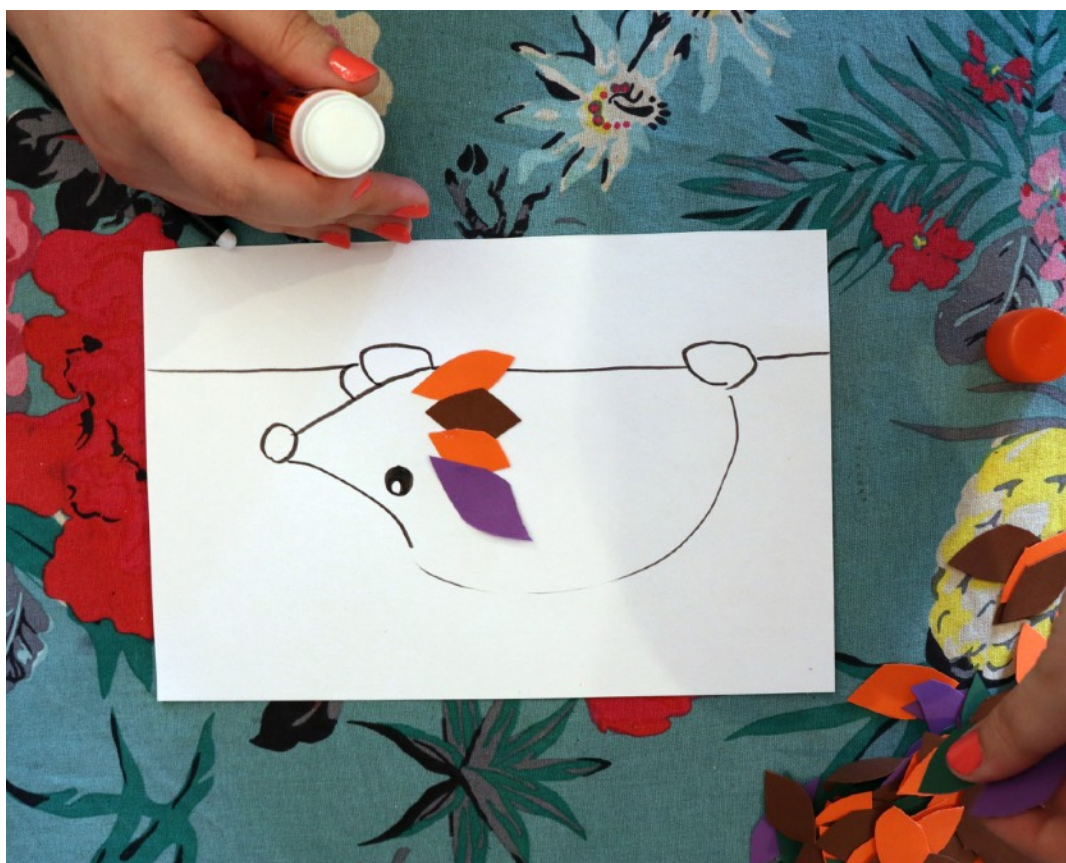
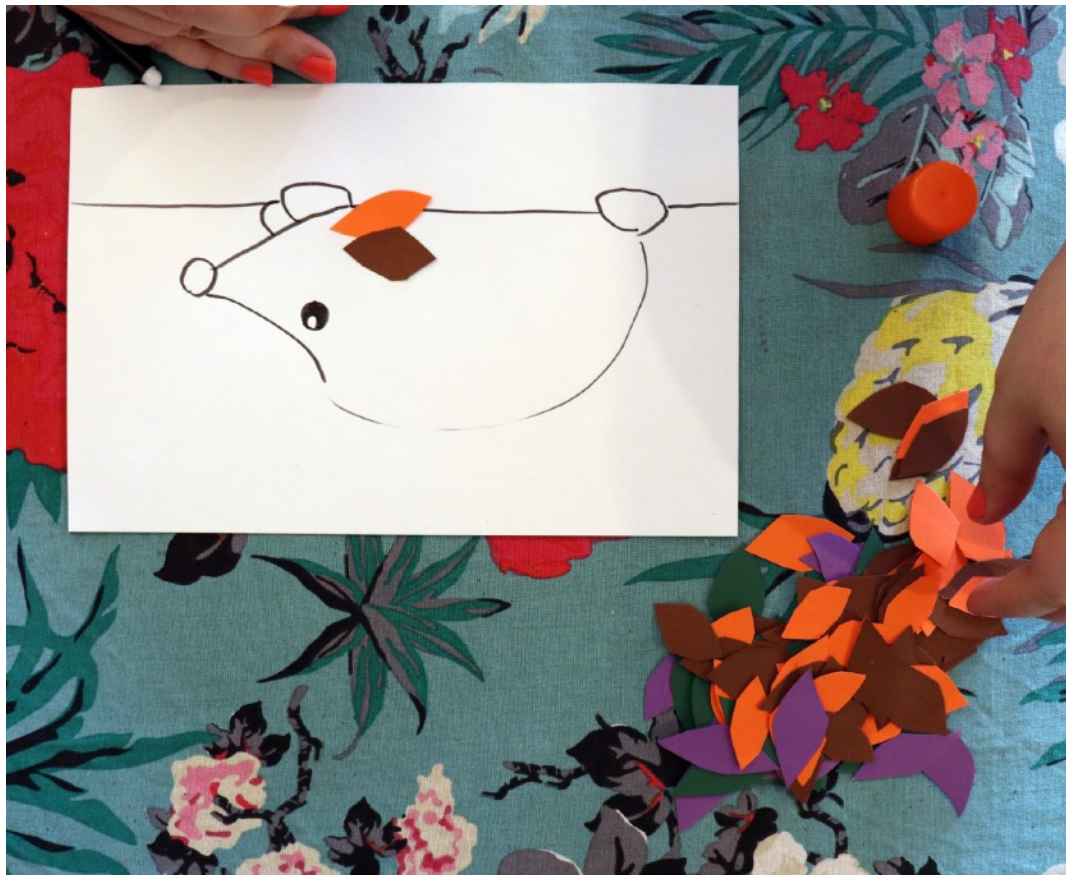
First of all you want to cut out all the leaf shapes to create the body of your hedgehog - it's spikes. Fold the paper so you can get multiple leaves at once, saves some time - just be mindful of how much you try to cut at once most scissors can only handle about 4 sheets



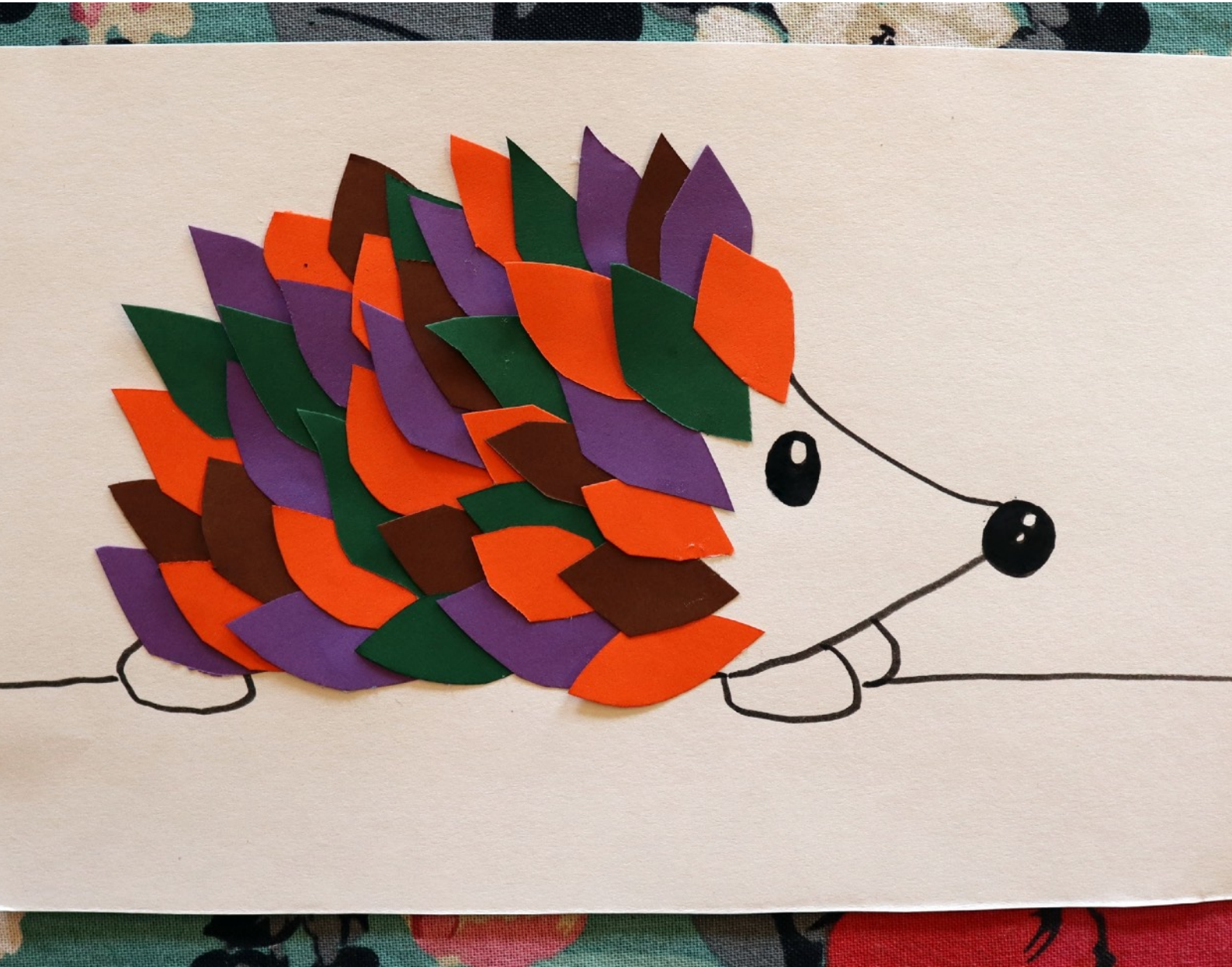
Now you can sketch out the shape of your hedgehog (without spikes) just the shape of the body like so



Once you are happy with your sketch you can start sticking the leaves on to make the spikes - how do you want the colours? Random scatter or lines? We went for random scatter on this one



There you have it your very own “Hedgehog Collage”!
