

World Giraffe Day



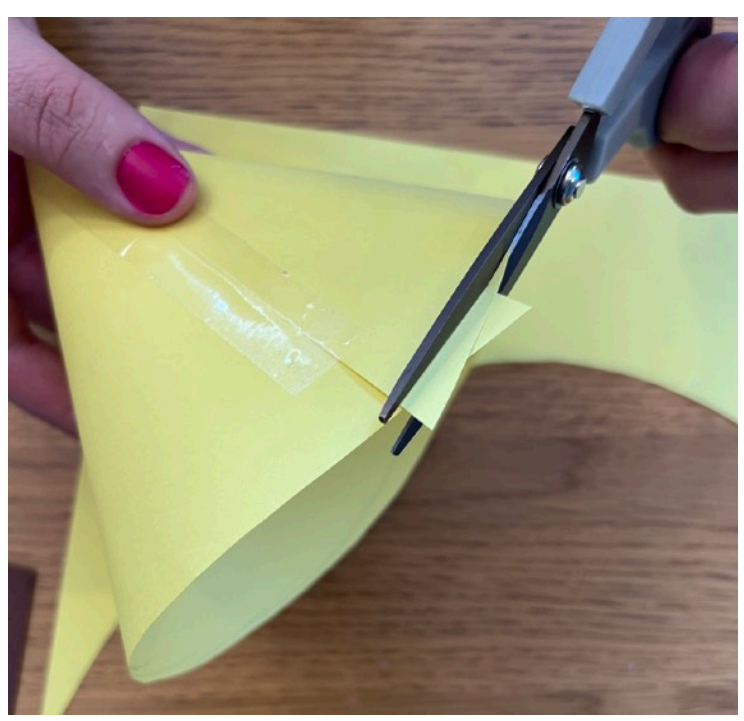
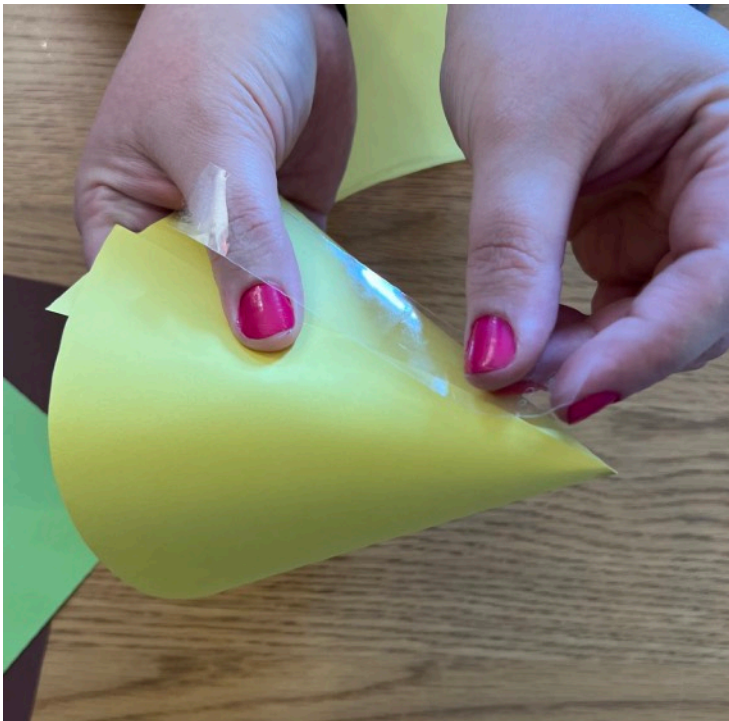
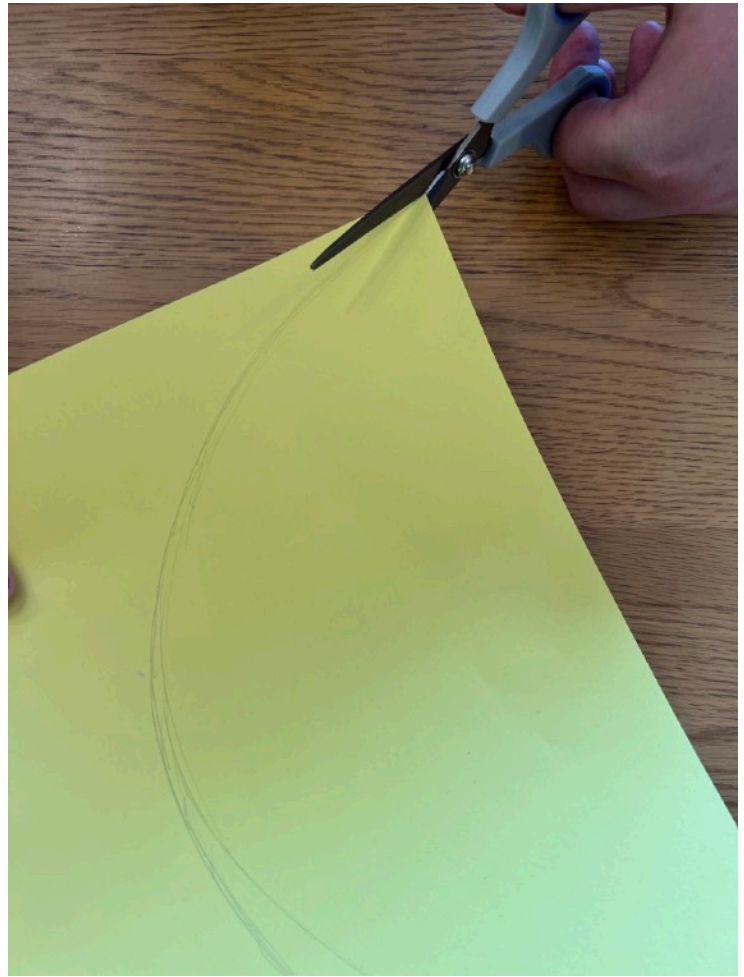
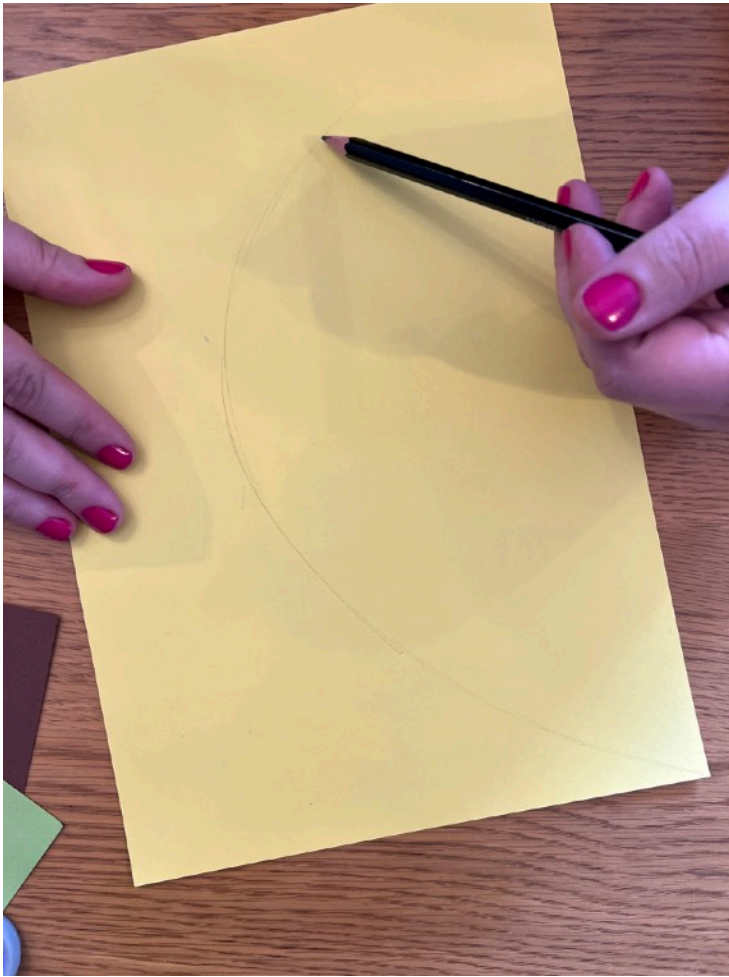
World Giraffe Day falls on the 21st June, bringing awareness around the conservation of our long necked friends! To celebrate this why not create your own 3D giraffe as a decoration!

Tools and Materials:

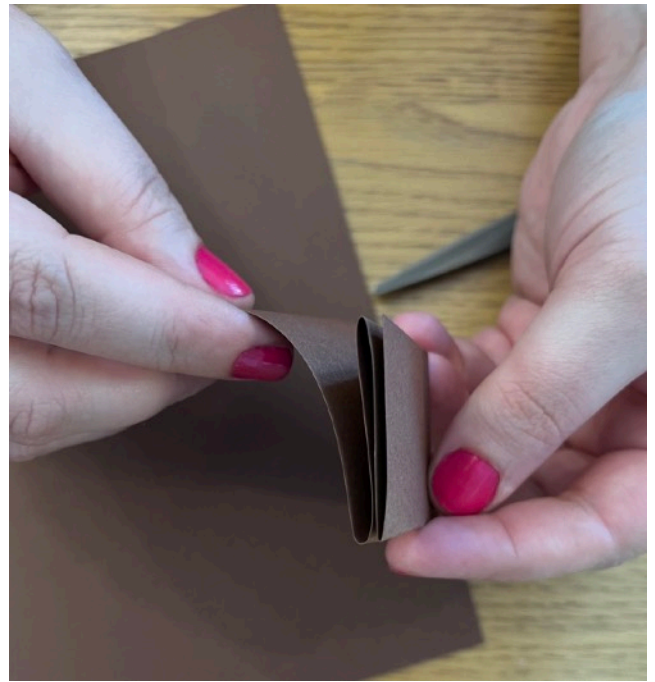
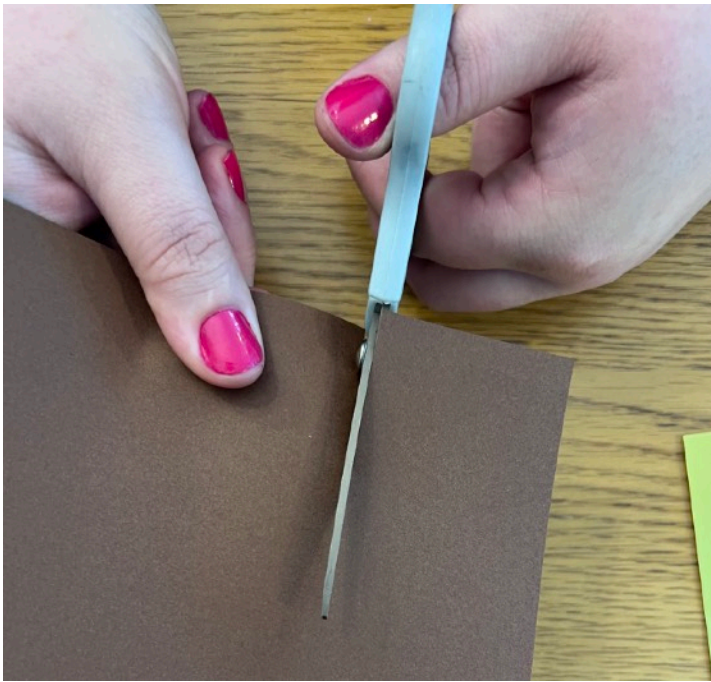
- Coloured Paper (Yellow, Brown, Orange & Green)
- Pencil
- Gluestick
- Scissors
- Sellotape



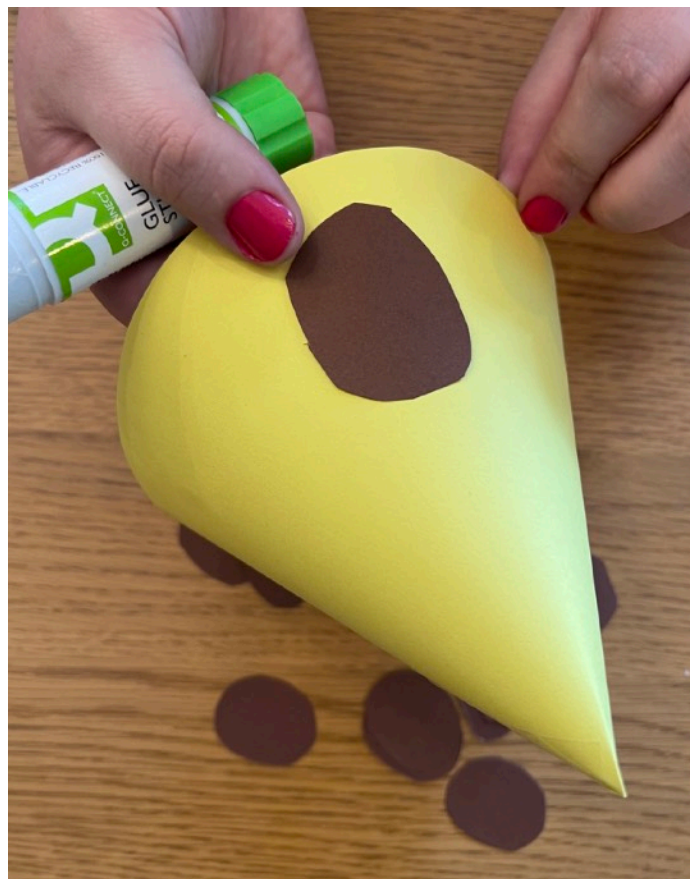
First of all create a semi circle on the yellow paper to form the base of your giraffe. It doesn't have to be perfect because you can trim it afterwards to refine it. Draw your semi-circle, cut it out - take the straight side and bend it in half to form the cone then tape it to secure. Trim to tidy up afterwards like so



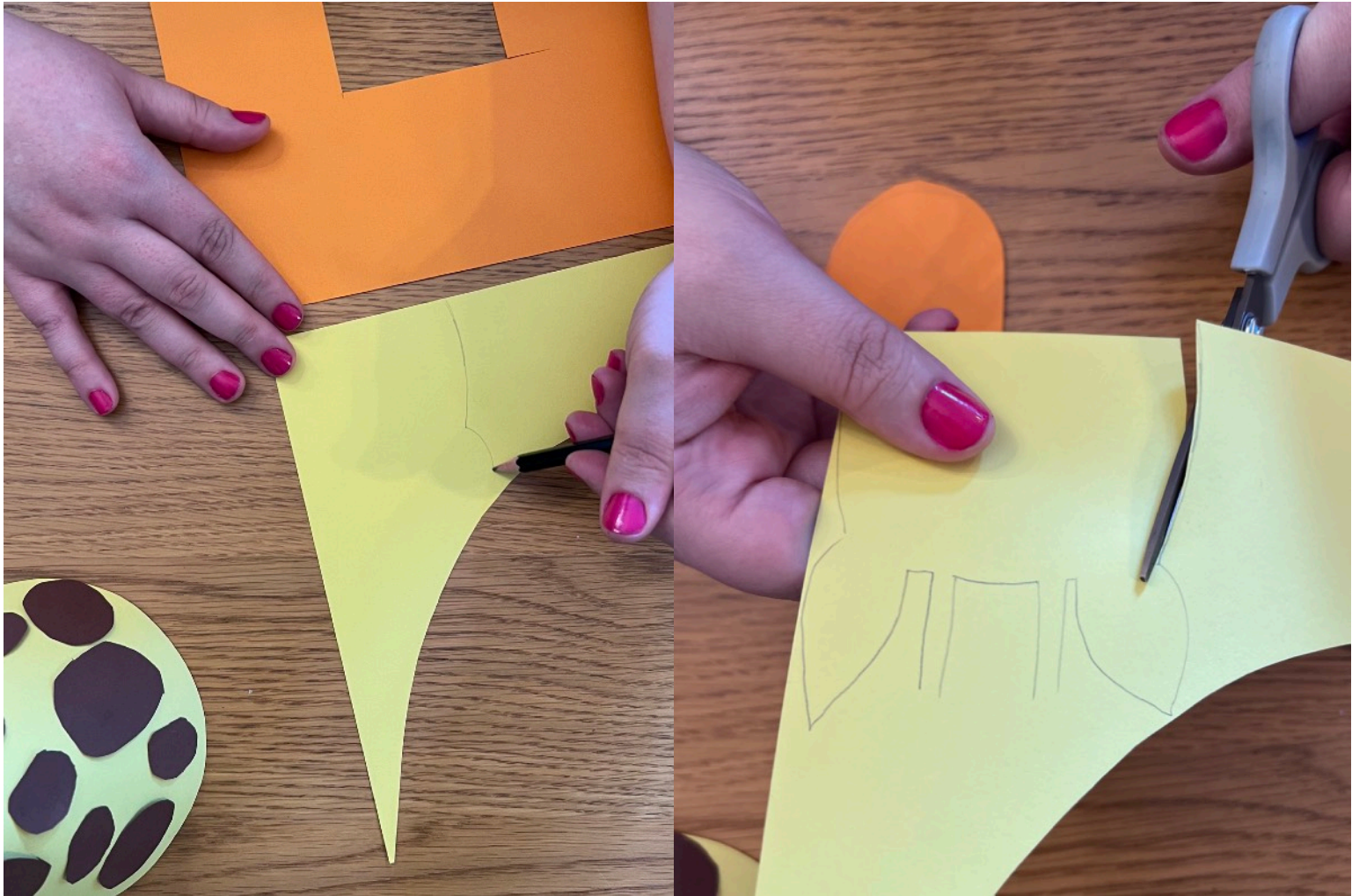
Once you have the base done you can create some brown spots to decorate the body to make a giraffes distinctive patterns. We simplified ours you can make them more like the actual pattern, whichever you prefer! To get multiple spots cut a strip and fold it so you can get 4 spots at once like so



Once you are happy with the spots then glue them on



With your leftover bit of yellow paper you can create a face like so, and then cut out other elements to decorate it like the mouth, nostrils, eyes and so on



Once you have all the the bits you want then you can stick them on - if you want any 3D-esque elements you can for tape over on itself like a sticky loop to make things on different levels, or you can just glue them



Once you have added all the bits on that you want to attach the head to the body with sellotape going across the point of the pyramid body and onto the back of the head



There you have it your very own
